any certainty that we would be able to stay in Ukraine as missionaries. The new laws introduced last August initially caused much confusion amongst the American community along with the uneasy feeling that someone was trying to get rid of us. Other countries, notably Russia, have enacted changes to their immigration policies which have effectively barred religious workers from obtaining any kind of long-term access. Happily, it now appears that Ukraine has not chosen that path.

Today, we are excited to inform you that we are registered. To put in another way, we have been issued official long-term residency cards which represent more certainty about our presence here than we've had for quite some time. For my family, the Beals, and Denise Hutchison, there are no more

steps, no more elusive documents to hunt down, no more stamps needed from reluctant officials. We're done.

Because Nathan and Katelin Day are currently in the U.S., they were



not able to complete this process with us. However, they are returning to Ukraine in about a month, and their documents are already in process. The things our team has learned along the way are helping to ensure that the Days' registration process will be even quicker and smoother than ours was. Nonetheless, it's not over 'til the fat lady sings, and we'd appreciate your continued prayers for the Day family. Right now, they are waiting to receive their class D visas from the Ukrainian consulate in San Francisco. They need these visas in their passports before they fly back to Ukraine on June 5.
