

We were VERY impressed by the medical staff, especially our birthing doctor, Tamara. Tamara is a believer and an accomplished medical professional. In fact, when Kels and I first arrived in the delivery room, the first thing Tamara wanted to do was pray with us. The three of us stood around in a circle and asked the Lord's blessing on Kelsie and the baby. Tamara's son, Pavlo, has done extensive translation work for our ministry, especially with the *Good and Evil* project.

Although we originally had some concerns about the prospect of

giving birth in Ukraine,
God was gracious to
guide and protect us
from start to finish.
The hospital facilities
were clean, completely
adequate, and perhaps
most importantly, the
staff were kind, professional and very accommodating. I was able to
be at Kelsie's side the
entire time - something
which is still rare here in Ukraine.

Some of you may recall that when Abby was born, Kels had been in labor for 36 hours straight. Although there were no complications as such, Kels and I were both utterly

exhausted when the ordeal was over. We prayed on numerous occasions that God would give us a quick labor with Rebekah. We are so grateful to Him for His mercy and faithfulness in answering those prayers.

meant by "believing in Jesus for salvation." She said that she had heard on numerous occasions that salvation is by faith alone, but was still confused as to what this meant. I again explained what salvation was, and that one could only find peace with God by ceasing to trust in one's own works (repentance FROM dead works) and beginning to trust solely in the finished work of Christ (repentance TOWARDS God.) As I went through a few different points, it was like a light came on for Olya. Once again, I had the privilege of seeing someone realize - perhaps for the first time - that Jesus did it all! The door is open. All we need to do is come.

To confirm that she had indeed understood, I asked her, "Olya, do you believe that Jesus died for you and that His sacrifice is ALL that is necessary to save you?" She affirmed that she did. I then asked, "Olya, have you ever thanked God (continued on page 4)

system, called CBC Admin, to manage all the data for our correspondence Bible course. Every student who enrolls in the course is added to CBC Admin, which tracks everything from contact information to grades to statistics. One of the more interesting and useful features of this program is the ability to run queries which can show pockets of students located in various geographical areas.

As our student base increases, we have noticed such pockets growing in several areas where we have ministered over past years.


#### The Seeds of a Church

One of the first villages we visited in 2006 is called Tukhlya. Located about three hours south of L'viv, Tukhlya was the site of our largest film showing to date. About 300 people viewed *The Light of the World* film and heard the Gospel

I assured her that this wouldn't be a problem - there's always lots to do in God's kingdom!

Please pray for Olya. As a new believer coming from a very Catholic background, she still has lots to learn. But her heart is tender, and she has made that most important of all human decisions: to rest completely in the finished work of her Savior. We rejoice to see how God brought this woman to Himself through the teaching of His Word, and we count it a privilege that we can continue teaching and proclaiming the Gospel of Christ to the Ukrainian people.

preached. Tukhlya is also home to one of our most advanced CBC students, a man named Ivan. Not only has Ivan shown himself very faithful in studying through the course, he has also signed up other students in his area. At present, we have five people in Tukhlya who are studying the Bible: three men, two women. We have never met these people face to face, but during CMO 2008 we plan to change that.

There are several areas which, like Tukhlya, are home to groups of our Bible students. This summer, in addition to reaching new towns with the Gospel, we are planning to begin visiting our students in the areas where we have ministered previously to see if we can take the relationship to the next level. It is our prayer that, as the Lord leads, these students will be the beginnings of churches across Western Ukraine.

It is not my place to predict how and where God will raise up indigenous churches in Ukraine. I am only a messenger. But the message we carry is powerful, it is wonderful, and it transforms lost sinners into overcoming saints. (Romans 1:16) As we are faithful to preach Christ to the lost and disciple the saved, God will build His church for His glory.

Please remember to pray for our ministry this year, and especially for the Bible students whom we plan to visit over the summer. We are optimistic that the Lord will open doors and that men and women will be saved as they receive the living Word of God.
